| Corporate ³ | Any company that generated a total annual turnover in Australia that equalled or exceeded \$10M in the last financial year, unless the company elects to apply for a higher membership tier. | \$15,000 | \$750 |
| Associate | Any company that generated a total annual turnover in Australia between \$1.5M and \$10M in the last financial year must be an Associate member, unless the company elects to apply for a higher membership tier. | \$5,000 | \$250 |
| Network | Any company that generated a total annual turnover in Australia up to \$1.5M in the last financial year must be a Network member, unless the company elects to apply for a higher membership tier. | \$2,500 | \$125 |
| Education | | | |
| Education Partner ³ | Any university or higher-education establishment that supports the mission and objectives of the EEC. | \$16,500 | \$825 |
| Government | | | |
| Government Partner ³ | Any government entity, including federal and state government departments and agencies and leading local governments. | \$9,500 | \$475 |

1. Applies to all memberships with a commencement or renewal date in FY2026. All figures are GST exclusive. Annual membership fees and tier thresholds are reviewed and approved by the EEC's Board.
2. Applies to payments made in full within 14 days of the membership renewal date. The Pay on Time (POT) discount does not apply to new memberships.
3. Membership tier is entitled to Senior Member benefits.
